ABOUT GC WIRELESS NETWORKS:

There are two wireless networks at the Graduate Center, GCcommunity and GC guest.

The *GCcommunity* wireless network is intended for use by Graduate Center students, faculty, and staff; it provides access to internal Graduate Center resources similar to those available on the wired network. This includes internal websites, printing, and network file shares. The *GCguest* wireless network is for use by guests and visitors to the Graduate Center; it provides access to the Internet via the web and other selected standard protocols; peer-to-peer file sharing is not permitted. Access to internal Graduate Center network resources for *GCguest* users is available via Graduate Center Remote IT Services (Citrix).

ACCESSING WIRELESS NETWORKS:

GCcommunity: Graduate Center students, faculty, and staff can use the *GCcommunity* wireless network, which is secured and encrypted. Connecting to *GCcommunity* requires your current Graduate Center network user-id and password. The first time you connect, some configuration of your computer, smartphone, or other wireless device will be required. Instructions for configuring a wireless profile at the Graduate Center are available from Information Technology at help.gc.cuny.edu/portal/ss/index.jsp.

GCguest: Graduate Center visitors and guests can use the *GCguest* wireless network, which is unsecured and unencrypted. No special configuration of your computer is required. Once you are connected, open a web browser and browse to any web page. You will then be directed to an authentication page; then enter any valid e-mail address and accept the terms of use.
